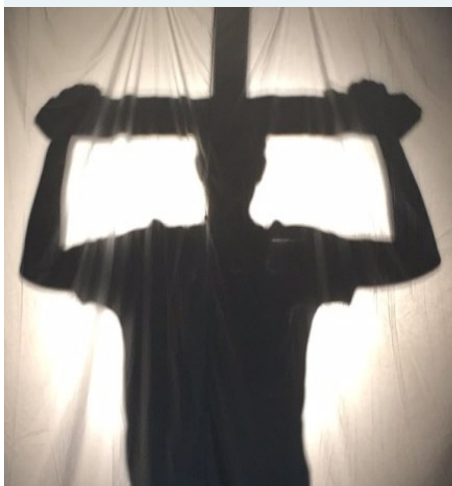


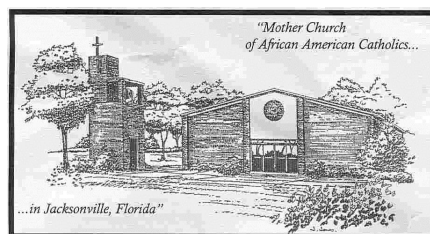

Everyday we are faced with new challenges and obstacles designed to derail us and keep us from the love of God. The world is filled with constant change, but the love that God has for us never changes. So we can never “complete” our education when it concerns Christ. We must continue to learn if we are to continue to grow. That lesson is true of life and our Catholic Christian faith.

...and that is the message that we deliver in our Catechism classes. It is not enough to simply attend Mass and Sunday School. How do we apply what we’ve learned? As we explore the Scriptures and teachings of Christ each week, we are tasked with living that message of love. The word “Catholic” means “All” and we are charged with being that Light of Christ to All we encounter. Our Catechism Instructors teach not only from approved Diocesan resource materials and literature but we help the youth to explore real life situations and examine current events to inspire their use of critical thinking skills and Biblical references to attain solutions to issues affecting them and their peers. “Lord, when did I see you hungry or naked?” “Whatever you do to the least of my brothers, that you do unto me.”

What Do We Do In Sunday School?

Safety is a primary concern of our Parish and the Diocese of St. Augustine. So rest assured, all of our Catechists have had background checks and fingerprinting. Early in the school year, we have a Touching Safety program that is administered by your child’s teacher. Classes are grouped according to age with activities and lessons that will teach and reinforce the tenets of our Catholic faith and beliefs.

Sunday School Classes begin at 9:00am and end at 10:15am, prior to Mass (which begins at 10:30am). Please come join us—we’re looking forward to learning about Jesus Christ and the Catholic Faith with you.

What Do We Do Outside of Sunday School?

Well, first of all, we aren’t your average Sunday School! Our Catechism classes are partnered with our St. Pius V Youth Ministry and we have one of the most active youth ministries in the Diocese of St. Augustine. Skits and plays are commonplace with our youth, who are usually very active in their respective schools and eagerly share their talents and skills with our faith community. During Lent, our youth are in charge of the final Stations of the Cross prior to Good Friday; we perform Easter programs for our Faith community and Christmas programs for the church and various facilities in the Jacksonville metropolitan area. St. Pius V Youth participate in various service projects throughout the city and at the church. Come visit us and see what we are all about!
